




Membership requires attending three semi-monthly meetings and attending one social meeting, be sponsored by two members that know the candidate and be elected by two-thirds of the members present at a regular


We have so many social events through out the year. Many include our wives or significant others. Here are just a few fun things we have done together... Social event participation is always optional.


